

THE COLLEGE ESSAY: A TUTORIAL

This is a 4-day, 13 hour tutorial workshop, which will be held the weeks of July 30-Aug. 2 and August 6-9. The session hours are: 9:00 am - 12:15, 1:00 pm - 4:15 pm, or 5:00 pm - 8:15 pm. This program is sponsored by the Cherry Hill Guidance Departments. Workshops will be held at Cherry Hill High Schools East and West. Enrollment will determine which sessions run and where.

Tutorials will contain a maximum of 10-12 students who will complete all steps of the writing process (from prewriting through production of a final draft) to create a college essay. In the tutorial, students will examine the diversity of topics for college essays, how to narrow the topics to fit the individual applicant, how to generate ideas for a rough draft, and how to revise and edit through peer reviews. By the end of the tutorial, students will complete a final draft of an essay to submit to a college. Areas for focus in the workshops may include the following:

The Purpose of the College Essay	Organizing Various Structures
Reading and Analyzing Sample Essays	Choosing a Writing Approach
Drafting Essays	Creating Time Lines of Accomplishments
Revising and Editing for Clarity	Focusing on the Active Voice
Writing Personal Narratives	Varying Sentence Length and Beginnings
Examining Topics, Attitudes, and Approaches	Using Appropriate Tone and Diction
Strategies for Writing	Creating a Personal Profile
Reviewing Do's and Don'ts for Essays	Participating in Peer Review

The fee for this course is **\$175** for all Cherry Hill high school students/residents and **\$225** for non-residents. The workshop is priced below cost to encourage maximum participation and to ensure affordability. Parents who can, may make extra contributions to help pay for students who cannot afford the fee and to subsidize our low cost fee. All contributions are tax exempt. All checks and registration forms must be submitted to the Guidance Department by **Tuesday, June 19, 2018**. Each registrant will receive a letter confirming registration, and another letter of final details a week before the workshop begins. We have tried to schedule the workshops so they will not conflict with pre-season training.
